## **Larry Moliterno Elected to CLOUT Executive Board**

Coalition of Large Ohio Urban Townships (CLOUT) has elected **Boardman Township Trustee Larry Moliterno** to serve on its 16-member Executive Committee, representing large urban townships across the State of Ohio.

CLOUT is a coalition of large, urban townships formed in 1994 to provide a forum for the exchange of problems, issues, and solutions for similarly sized townships in Ohio, while also offering input to the Ohio Township Association (OTA). Membership in CLOUT requires a population of at least 15,000 residents in the unincorporated area of the township or a budget exceeding \$3 million.

The CLOUT Executive Committee consists of 16 members representing four regions of the state. Members are elected at the annual meeting held in conjunction with the OTA Winter Conference. The Executive Committee meets four times annually and is responsible for establishing legislative priorities for each Ohio General Assembly. In addition, CLOUT members may seek support in litigation matters through amicus curiae briefs, which are considered by OTA staff and the Executive Committee.

Trustee Moliterno's election to the Executive Committee highlights Boardman Township's leadership role among Ohio's large urban townships. His appointment ensures that Boardman will have a direct voice in shaping statewide legislative priorities that impact township governance, public safety, infrastructure, and fiscal stability.

"Larry's experience and commitment to responsible local government make him an excellent representative for Boardman and for large urban townships throughout Ohio," said Boardman Township Fiscal Officer Brad Calhoun. "His election to the CLOUT Executive Board reflects the respect he has earned among his peers across the state."

As one of Ohio's largest townships, Boardman continues to be active in statewide policy discussions affecting townships and local communities. Trustee Moliterno's service on the CLOUT Executive Committee will further strengthen Boardman's engagement at the state level.
