SAFE ROUTES BOARDMAN

What is Safe Routes?

The purpose of Safe Routes to School is to encourage and enable K-8 students to walk or ride their bicycles to school. The program is administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation.

Who else has done this?

In September 2018, ODOT announced that Youngstown received nearly \$400,000 for Safe Routes to School funding. The program has also been used in Poland, Canfield, Lowellville and many other communities in the region.

What can the funds be used for?

Safe Routes funding can be used for physical improvements (engineering) such as improved crosswalks, sidewalks, lighting, etc.. Funds can also be used for education and encouragement programming, such as bicycle rider/pedestrian training and a frequent pedestrian/rider program.


